What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the IVCM iShares Core Moderate Fund (**Fund**) has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the Fund with other funds. Lifetime Asset Management Limited (**Lifetime**) prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of this Fund


The Fund is 100% invested in the iShares Core Moderate Allocation ETF (**Underlying Fund**). The investment objective is to seek potential income and moderate to low capital growth by tracking the performance of the S&P Target Risk Moderate Index, a multi-asset class index with a 60% allocation to international fixed interest and 40% allocation to international equities.

The Underlying Fund is a fund of funds and seeks to achieve its investment objective by investing primarily through passive, index-tracking investment funds managed by the underlying investment manager or associated investment managers that themselves seek investment returns corresponding to their own respective underlying indexes. The performance objective is to track the S&P Target Risk Moderate Index before fees and taxes.

What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the IVCM iShares Core Moderate Fund:



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.


Example of how this applies to an investor¹

Ben had USD \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Ben received a return after fund charges were deducted of USD \$430 (that is \$4.30% of his initial USD \$10,000). Ben also paid USD \$0.00 in other charges. This gives Ben a total return after tax of USD \$430 for the period.

What does the Fund invest in?


Actual investment mix
